

## News Update:

Please make you are checking your on line invoice for Team Unify. Late fees have been attached to any invoice that has 30 days past due for registration fees, and have not made the payment that was due November 1. Another \$10 late fee will be attached December 1 if payment not received. Also, many escrow accounts are beginning to get low or see a negative balance. Meet fees have been billed thru the November 8 meet. Many accounts will go into past due after the WEst Great Lakes open, so please make sure you sent payment in order to avoid past due fees. If you have a minus (-) in front of your bottom balance, it means you still have a credit in your account, accounts without a minus sign have past due amounts.

**CODE OF CONDUCT:** During on site registration for new families we talked about the importance of being good stewards of the high school facilities that we use in order to run our program. This is a reminder to new and seasoned families who may have forgotten! Please when we are in the locker rooms and pool area, we need to leave everything in better condition than when we got there. If anything is observed, vandalism, excessive litter, please let our coaches know so that we can notify custodians before SWAT gets blamed. Recently our coaches have reported that the showers at Whitnall are being left on full blast with hot water creating a very steamy locker room. This has been brought to Coach Cheryl's attention in the past by parents and she has walked in there and they were left on once again, even after reminding everyone. This is happening quite often, and when custodians find it – it leaves a bad impression on them/and the school district over our usage of their facilities. Parents, please remind your swimmers to turn off showers, and pick up after themselves after practice. If you are one of the last parents thru the locker rooms, please make sure the showers get turned off before leaving.

Also, the weight room attendant has approached us to inform us that younger siblings are being left unattended in the hallways and she has had to leave the weight room to yell at the kids. They are playing by the doors and the handicap switch to the doors. She doesn't want SWAT to get in trouble so she asked me to bring this to the attention of the parents. SWAT only has contracts with the districts for the pool and locker rooms – all other areas are off limits. Parents who bring siblings are reminded that they MUST remain with their parent in the pool area. Muskego HS has video cameras on all areas of their facility – we can't afford to jeopardize our contracts with the school districts. Without pools – we don't have a program so please help us, by keeping a closer eye on your non-swimmers at practice. Thanks.
